Thank you for registering for the 2019 SCASA Innovative Ideas Institute, June 16–19, 2019! We're looking forward to seeing you and we appreciate your support! Below is important information as you make your final preparations for the conference. **Please read all information carefully.**

General Sessions – IMPORTANT!!!!!!

Monday's general session will be held in the Palisades Conference Center at the Hilton Resort from 8:30 a.m.–10:00 a.m. The Hilton Resort is a five (5) minute walk from the Embassy Suites on the Boardwalk. The Boardwalk can be accessed from any of the hotel towers and at the pool area of the Embassy Suites. Volunteers will be located along the Boardwalk to direct you to the Hilton Palisades Conference Center. Shuttles will also be available from the Embassy Suites, condo and villa areas. Wednesday's general session will be held in the Kensington Ballroom at the Embassy Suites.

Registration

Conference registration will begin at 3:00 p.m. and end at 7:00 p.m. on Sunday, in the **Pembroke room at the Embassy Suites**. Signs will be located in the hallways to direct you to the registration area. **We encourage all participants to register on Sunday evening because you MUST pick up your registration materials before attending the Opening General Session on Monday morning. Monday's general session will be held in the Palisades Conference Center at the Hilton Resort.** Registration will open at 7:30 a.m. on Monday, June 17, for those who are unable to register on Sunday.

Parking and Shuttle Information

Attached is a pre-printed parking pass for the Embassy Suites and Hilton. Please print this pass and place in you dash when you arrive at Kingston Plantation to prevent long lines at the entrance gate.

If you forget your pass, please tell the guard at the gate that you are with the SCASA Innovative Ideas Institute and you will receive a pre-printed parking pass for the entire week.

There will be security guards throughout the property to direct you to open parking spaces. Shuttles will pick up in various locations on the property. Please click on the link below to view the shuttle map and times. Again, we encourage you to register on Sunday, June 16.
